



Foxearth Pleasure and Traditional Lake Rules, Times and Prices

- All Anglers must have a valid Environment Agency rod licence
- All Anglers must purchase a ticket upon arrival.
- Every Angler must be in possession of a suitably sized unhooking mat, weigh sling and landing net.
- You must possess a suitable disgorger and forceps.
- 2 Rods maximum. (1 rod only on traditional lake)
- Barbless hooks only.
- No spinning.
- The management reserve right to check your rigs on request.
- No sacking of fish.
- No keep nets.
- Fish should be returned to the water as soon as possible and handling kept to a minimum.
- Do not handle fish with cloths.
- Rods not to be left unattended.
- Fishing from pegs only.
- No fires allowed.
- Do not attempt to prune trees, cut or damage the vegetation.
- Alcohol permitted in moderation.
- All litter must be removed from your peg and deposited in the bins provided. If bins are full, or items are too large then please take them home. (Foxearth Fisheries operate a zero tolerance policy on littering)
- Anyone found taking fish will be prosecuted.
- No under 16s without an adult or prior management consent.

The pleasure lake rules apply to the traditional coarse lake with the exception of:

- Adults only
- Only one rod or pole

The Management reserves the right to amend or add to these rules, if in doubt about the above or anything that may not be mentioned, please contact the management.

These rules are in place to protect the fish and environment, any Angler in breach of these rules will be asked to leave.

Times

Summer Season: 1st April until 30th October

Winter Season: 1st November until 31st March

The Fishery is closed on Wednesdays for maintenance

Summer

Day: 8am to 8pm or dusk (*which ever falls first*)

If registered it may be possible to fish earlier than 8am but the fishery closes at 8pm.

Evening: 4pm to 8pm or dusk (*which ever falls first*)

The fishery closes at 8pm.

Night carp fishing: 8pm to 8am

The fishery closes at 8pm.

(Registration is necessary and is £10.00 per year)

Winter

Day: 8am until dusk

Night carp fishing: 8pm to 8am

(Registration is necessary and is £10.00 per year)

Summer Season Prices

Day Ticket: **Adults** £ 6.00 **Juniors** £4.00

Evening Ticket: **Adults** £ 3.00 **Juniors** £2.50

Night carp fishing ticket: **Adults** £ 10.00 **Juniors** £8.00 (adult accompanied)

(Registration is necessary and is £10.00 per year)

Winter Season Prices

Day Ticket: **Adults** £ 5.00 **Juniors** £3.00

Night carp fishing ticket: **Adults** £ 8.00 **Juniors** £6.00

(Registration is necessary and is £10.00 per year)
