



Foxearth Carp Lake Rules, Times and Prices

Rules

- All Anglers must have a valid Environment Agency rod licence
- All Anglers must collect their ticket upon arrival.
- Every Angler must be in possession of a suitably sized unhooking mat, weigh sling and landing net.
- 2 rods, 3rd may be used (conditions apply), 2 Rods maximum if sharing a zone.
- Barbless and Micro-barbed hooks only.
- Safety rigs only.
- The management reserve right to check your rigs on request.
- No sacking of fish.
- Fish should be returned to the water as soon as possible and handling kept to a minimum.
- No fishing for the Pike
- Rods not to be left unattended, no further than the next zone on your side of the lake. (to cover yourself remember the Environment Agency regulation)
- Tiger Nuts and Peanuts as hook bait only.
- Pre-baiting by appointment and only available to registered anglers
- Prior permission is needed for Spectators, do not give code to spectators and spectators must be off site before closing.
- No fires allowed.
- Disposable barbeques allowed on gravelled areas only.
- Do not attempt to prune trees, cut or damage the vegetation.
- Alcohol permitted in moderation.
- Any socials should be held away from the lakeside and lines should be reeled in. (Please respect other Anglers and keep noise to a minimum).
- All litter must be removed from your peg and deposited in the bins provided. If bins are full, or items are too large then please take them home. (Foxearth Fisheries operate a zero tolerance policy on littering)
- Anyone found taking fish will be prosecuted.

The Management reserves the right to amend or add to these rules, if in doubt about the above or anything that may not be mentioned, please contact the management.

These rules are in place to protect the fish and environment, any Angler in breach of these rules will have their registration suspended.

Times

Summer Season: 1st April until 30th October

Winter Season: 1st November until 31st March

The Fishery is closed on Wednesdays for maintenance (with plenty of notice it is still possible to fish a Wednesday when fishing a block booking)

Times are the same for the summer and winter season

Day: 8am to 8pm

If registered it may be possible to fish earlier than 8am if your zone is free, but you must vacate your zone by 8pm.

Night: 8pm to 8am

It may be possible to fish earlier than 8pm if your zone is free, but you must vacate your zone by 8am if it is booked or you may stay until 10am if it is not booked. If you are fishing after 10am you will be charged for the day.

24hr: 8am to 8am

If registered it may be possible to fish earlier than 8am if your zone is free, but you must vacate your zone by 8am the following day if it is booked or you may stay until 10am if it is not booked. If you are fishing after 10am you will be charged for the day.

24hr: 8pm to 8pm

If registered it may be possible to fish earlier than 8pm if your zone is free, but you must vacate your zone by 8pm the following evening.

24hrs notice must be given of any cancellation or the full amount will still be payable. Prices below are for 2 rods, a 3rd rod is charged at £2.00 per 12hrs. When a zone is shared add half to the prices below for the second person.
